For the WUSA Board and Auxiliary, the holidays are no doubt the calm before the storm. The New Year brings the excitement of a new spring softball season – tryouts, drafts, team meetings, the start of practices, and the Opening Day Parade & Carnival. As we wrap up another successful Fall Ball season and look forward to our spring season, we wanted to update you all on a few happenings around the league.

Fall 2019 Recap

WUSA's 2019 fall ball season was its largest ever with 425 registered players. This registration number surpassed some of our league's <u>spring</u> registration totals from not that many years ago. We thank our families who continue to come back and support our league and we welcome the newcomers who are trying WUSA for the first time.

This fall's weather was certainly favorable for softball. There were only a handful of rained out games, with no rainouts occurring on any of our Sunday game days. The league's recently purchased tarps (along with the parent volunteers who helped roll them out on the infields) got the assist for saving two weeknight sets of games. We now have tarps for all five of our fields at South Campus and look forward to making good use of these infield covers this coming spring.

Pink Out Day and the Hit-a-thon on October 20 were once again very fun, successful events for our league. That Sunday afternoon we saw a steady stream of hit-a-thonners of all ages hitting line drives at pink targets (and occasionally at some coaches). The pink socks and pink shirts were on full display across South Campus. In the end, we were able to raise a total of \$19,000, with the funds being divided as follows: \$7,000 to the WUSA College Scholarship Fund, \$7,000 to WUSA's capital improvement projects, and \$5,000 to be donated to The Rose, in support of Breast Cancer Awareness. Thank you all for your support of each of these important causes and fundraising efforts.

This final tournament was held at South Campus, which marked the first time WUSA has hosted a fall
